

Guidelines for Abstract Submission and Travel Awards

Abstract submission is possible by email only, please send your completed abstract template and contact information to: lgbiro.garcia@gmail.com. You will receive acknowledgement of receipt afterwards.

Submission Deadline: 31 July 2024

Abstracts **of topics related to intracerebral hemorrhage (including both original clinical or translational research)** will be selected for **Oral Presentations**. The scientific committee reserves the possibility to organize a poster session according to the amount and quality of received abstracts.

Abstract Template:

- Should not contain more than 350 words.
- Should be written in English.
- should use the following structure: Introduction, Aims, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- Include complete names and affiliations of all authors, the presenting Author should be highlighted in bold.

The submitter declares, that all named authors agree to the release of their names and affiliation in relation to this contribution. All accepted contributions are going to be released in the online program for the conference after they have been accepted by the program committee. The submitter declares: that this submission is free of rights from any.

Travel Awards include complete registration (accommodation at Alimara Hotel, meeting registration and meals). Transportation will not be covered by the travel award. **Who can apply?** Early Career Investigators (ECI) included in one of these categories:

Student Early Career Investigators: Students who are enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate, professional degree, or medical specialty program (e.g., bachelor's, master's or PhD student; graduate student; medical student; neurology, neurosurgery or anesthesia resident or trainee).

Scholar Early Career Investigators: Those with a PhD, MD or equivalent degree who have been in a research training program for less than 5 years since obtaining their last degree (e.g., research fellow; postdoctoral associate; postdoctoral fellow).

Full Early Career Investigators: Scientists with PhD, MD or equivalent who either (1) have begun independent tracks leading to or with their own groups within the last 6 years, or (2) who are not in an independent track but have begun employment in a research program, typically under the direction of a more senior scientist, within the last 6 years (e.g., staff scientist, research associate).

How to apply: please send a short Biosketch (maximum 2 pages specifying the condition of ECI) to the following address lgbiro.garcia@gmail.com. Those applicants submitting abstracts will be prioritized.

Important: The submission of an abstract does not replace the registration as a participant to the conference. Registration for the conference is still necessary, unless you are granted with an ECI Travel Award.

Decision: The decision to accept/reject an abstract is made by the scientific committee based on the results of the review, as well as on the sponsorship of travel awards. Presenting authors will be informed the second week of August 2024 by email. The organisational details will be communicated directly to the authors prior to the conference.
